About the program

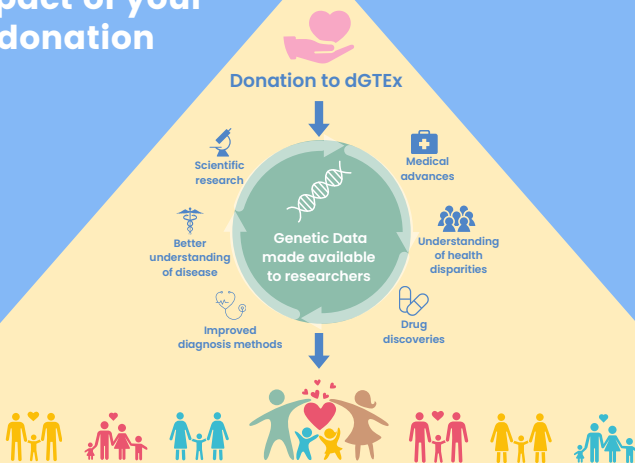
dGTEEx is a collaborative pediatric research effort that aims to help scientists understand how genes affect our health at different stages of development.
